Notice of Lease & Lessee Acknowledgment

In accordance with Section 8.1 (b), "Leasing Permits" as contained in the Association's Covenants/By-Laws, "Owners desiring to lease their Unit may do so only if they have applied for and received from the Board a "leasing permit", or "hardship leasing permit" pursuant to an application process to be promulgated by the Board."

THEREFORE: Pursuant to Section 8.6, "Leasing Provisions:"

- (a) Notice: At least 7 days prior to entering into the lease of a Unit, the Owner shall provide a copy of the proposed lease agreement to the Board.
- (b) Form of Lease: The Board may approve or disapprove the form of said lease. If the lease is disapprove, the Board shall notify the Owner of the requisite action to be taken in order to bring the lease in compliance with the Declaration and any rules and regulations adopted pursuant thereto.
- (c) General: Units may be leased only in their entirety. No fraction or portion of a Unit may be leased. There shall be no subleasing of Units or assignment of leases without prior written Board approval. Any lease must provide a term of at least one year. Within 10 days after executing a lease agreement for the lease of a Unit, the Owner shall provide the Board with a copy of the lease, the name of the lessee and all other people occupying the Unit and the Owner's address and other contact information other than at the Unit. The Owner must provide the lessee copies of the Governing Documents.

The Lease Agreement must contain the complete name(s) and contact information for each tenant and must include the following language:

"We/I the tenant(s) agree to be subject to the terms and conditions of the Association's governing documents, rules and regulations. We/I understand that failure to comply will result in applicable fine(s) to be levied due and payable in full to the Association within ten (10) days of such assessment. We/I also understand that repeated failure to comply with any aspect of said Association governing documents may result in termination of this lease."

Please review this document, Kensley's Community Covenants, and Rules and Regulations to ensure compliance with all neighborhood requirements and provisions.

8.2. Maximum Allowable Leases. An Owner's application for a leasing permit shall be considered if the number of then current, outstanding leasing permits for Lots, including the request then under consideration, does not exceed the "Maximum Allowable Leases." The Maximum Allowable Leases is defined as 7 Lots.
